True family name stated to be Cramer, Albert Sister: Mrs Dulcie Rose Paul, 9 Garfield Street, Cheltenham, Victoria Date of Birth: 20th July 1899 (stated 20 years and 5 months on enlistment) in Prahran, Victoria. Soldier walked to Albury with swag and attempted enlistment in Sydney but directed to have eye operation. Apparently refused and returned to Victoria. Connection with Monbulk unknown.
