Other details	Discharged on 5th April 1920 Medals: 1914 - 15 Star, British War Medal, Victory Medal Admitted to ship hospital with Scabies on his journey home. Described as 6 ft., 176 lb., blue eyes and silver hair. 1919 Australian census shows Michael working in Monbulk as a Labourer Born 1882 in Melbourne to Mary <i>nee</i> Duggan and John English Died 1937. Aged 55
