Other details	Medals: 1914 - 15 Star, British War Medal, Victory Medal Discharged 28th July 1916 with Muscular Rheumatism. Born 1886 in Williamstown, Victoria. Described as 5 ft., 4 1/2 in., 9 st., 4 lb., blue grey eyes and dark brown hair. Married Emily Christina Henderson. Mail went to Olinda Post Office.
