Described as 5 ft., 7 3/4 in., 11 stone, blue eyes and fair hair. 3rd Son of James A. McAllister (who served in R.N. Reserve. Served Boxer Riots 1900 - 1901) and Lilius Jane (Lily)(<i>nee</i> Park). All five brothers all enlisted. Married Almyra Victoria Streader in 1915. Died 1975 in Melbourne aged 83
