Other details	Medals: 1914 - 15 Star, British War Medal, Victory Medal 5th Son of James A. McAllister (who served in R.N. Reserve. Served Boxer Riots 1900 - 1901) and Liliast Jane (Lily)(<i>nee</i> Park). All five brothers all enlisted. Described as 5 ft., 5¼ in., 120 lb., grey eyes and dark brown hair. Born in 1897. Married Myrtle Adelia Streader. Died 1st September 1970.
