As Unit had left camp for embarkation this counted as an embarkation for overseas and Unit ranked as returned status.
Medals: 1914 - 15 Star, British War Medal, Victory Medal
4th Son of James A. McAllister (who served in R.N. Reserve. Served Boxer Riots 1900 - 1901) and Lilius Jane (Lily) (*nee* Park). All five brothers all enlisted.
Born in 1893. Described as 5 ft., 8 in., 138 lb., blue eyes and fair hair. Married Agnes May Berry in 1936.
