1917 11th November	Transferred to England hospital. Bronchitis.
1918 March	Hospital ship to Egypt. Held in Egyptian Hospital until fit to continue voyage to Australia.
Fate	Returned to Australia 12th July 1918 per <i>Port Darwin</i>
Other details	Admitted to Caulfield Hospital for many months with continual recurrences onwards through the years to 1950. Complete invalid in 1950. Medals: 1914 - 15 Star, British War Medal, Victory Medal Born 1881 in Talbot, Victoria to Hannah Laverick <i>nee</i> Nunn and John McLeod. Described as 5 ft., 7¼ in., 124 lb., brown eyes and black hair. Married Susan McLeod. 2 sons Hector born 1902 and younger son with physical disability. Death details unknown.
