1917 11th June	Wounded in Action. Gun shot wound to left arm.
1917 21st June	Rejoined Unit
1918 30th March	Sick in hospital rejoined Unit 19th May
1918 8th August	Again wounded and rejoined Unit after treatment - then continuously with Unit in France until November 1918.
Fate	Returned to Australia 5th April 1919 per SS <i>Warwickshire</i>
Other Details	Discharged 21st September 1919 Medals: 1914 - 15 Star, British War Medal, Victory Medal Born 1889 in Lilydale to Jane nee Robinson and Robert Nation. Married Doris Roberts. 1919 Electrol Roll shows Harry living in Monbulk, occupation Mill employee. Died 1964 in Bendigo aged 75.
