Fate	Returned to Australia 30th August 1918. Embarked Alexandria on duty per Transport <i>Wiltshire</i> . Disembarked Melbourne 3rd October 1918.
Other details	Discharged Melbourne 18th October 1918. Medals: 1914 - 15 Star, British War Medal, Victory Medal. Died Hawthorn, Victoria 13th April 1921 and buried Burwood Cemetery.
