And so on.....

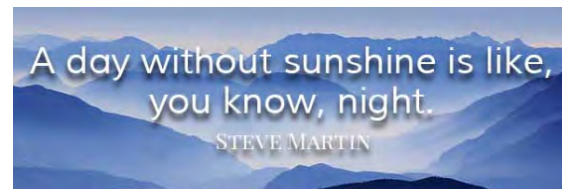


JOKE OF THE WEEK
