"Hi, my names Joe, I'm here for Flo, we're going to the show, is she ready to go?"

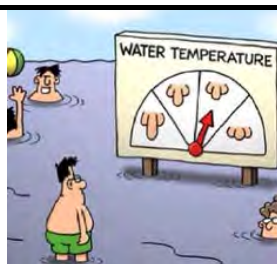
The farmer looked him over and sent the kids on their way. The next lad arrived.
