DARKY STILL OUT IN FRONT.....

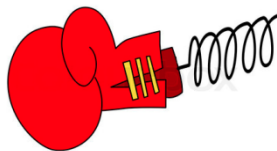
Darky is still showing a clean set of heels to all comers. Can he hang on? Will the pressure of leading since round 4 get to him? Probably not, but we are all still having a crack!
