He then takes out a scent bottle and starts spraying perfume over them. Artie's curiosity gets the better of him and he walks over to the man and asks him what he's doing.

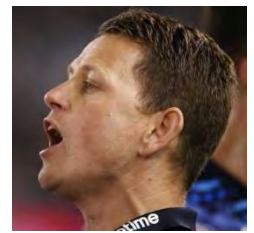
"I'm sending out 1,000 Valentine's Day cards signed, 'Guess who?'" says the man.
