D on D's ADVENTURES

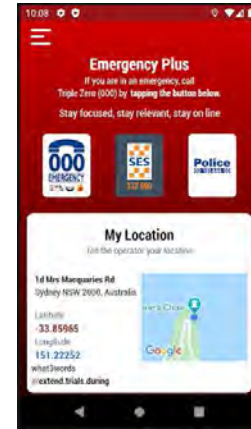
